### Reading Goal:

The 2017 SC Ready ELA indicate that 37% of our students met the ELA standard. During the 2017-2018 school year, the percentage of students (grades 3-5) meeting/exceeding expectations on the SC Ready ELA test will be 42%% (93 out of 218) or greater.

### Math Goal:

The 2017 SC Ready Math Assessment indicates that 40% of our students met or exceeded the standard. During the 2017-2018 school year, the percentage of students (grades 3-5) meeting/exceeding expectations on the SC Ready Math test will be 45% (99 out of 218) or greater.
