During the 2022-2023 school year, the percentage of students (grades 3-5) Meeting/Exceeding Expectations on ELA SC Ready will increase from 72.2% (91/126) in spring 2021 to 75.8% (100 out of 132) in spring 2023.



During the 2022-2023 school year, the percentage of students (grades 3-5) meeting/exceeding expectations on math SC Ready will increase from 73.8% (93/126) to 77.3% (102/132) in spring 2023.



Based on our school's report card, (school climate area), we will maintain or increase student attendance rate of 96.2%.
