### Academic Goals

The staff strives to enable all students to master the South Carolina State Standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. The results of our most recent state assessments rank our school as one of the district's and state's top elementary schools in English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies and Mathematics. Our goals for the SC Ready call for the percentage of students Meeting/Exceeding expectations on math will increase from 80% to 83% and for the percentage of students Meeting/Exceeding expectations on English language arts to increase from 79% to 82%.

To enhance our educational program and provide our staff and students with authentic opportunities to build their skills we have participated in professional development opportunities throughout the year. Our staff had four main focus areas: Engagement, PLC's, Coveys 7 Habits, and Academic Discourse. We began the year with our entire staff participating in the Get Your Teach On program. Our staff learned of new strategies for authentic engagement through challenging, hands on activities via a classroom and or a school-wide transformation. Every classroom experienced a transformation or two throughout the year with tremendous success. Student engagement increased drastically. Our Staff continued our professional development work with our Professional Learning Communities focusing on utilization of data to enhance our daily instruction and build in the areas of enrichment and remediation. We had a unique opportunity for our school community to adopt Covey's 7 Habits and The Leader In Me, and finally Academic Discourse has been a key in providing our students with an opportunity to use and develop their voice more completely. This has truly been a year of growth for our staff and students.
