Academic Goals: 2013-14

As a continuous improvement school, we set annual academic goals for the building as a whole, for each grade level and for each classroom. The students even learn how to set individual goals for themselves. Then over the course of the year, strategies are put into place to help us reach the goals, and periodic measurements are used to evaluate progress. Our building goals for this year include:
