## A HISTORY OF EXCELLENCE

Welcome Elementary School has a long history of excellence in education, care and concern for students and a strong involvement within the community. By working closely with the school's administration, Greenville County district officials, PTA and community citizens, Welcome Elementary School has been successful in maintaining the standard of excellence of the past, while working to secure that standard for future generations to come.

## A PURPOSEFUL PRESENT

Resolved: To give an annual report to our concerning Welcome's progress toward its goals and objectives, as outlined in our strategic plan and as aligned with the Education Plan of the School District of Greenville County.

Goal #1: Raise the academic challenge and community performance of each student

### Specific objectives:

- Maintain the percentage of all students in grades 3-5 meeting standard in math on PASS (Palmetto Assessment of State Standards) at state levels.
- Maintain the percentage of all students in grades 3-5 meeting standard in reading on PASS at state levels.

Goal #3: Provide a school environment supportive of learning

Goal #4: Effectively manage and further develop necessary financial resources

Goal #5: Improve public understanding and support of public schools

## A Record of Results

Significant gains in student achievement in the last three years have been made in both **MAP** (Measures of Academic Progress) and **PASS** (Palmetto Assessment of State Standards) testing. School achievement goals based on MAP testing were met or exceeded in both Reading and Math. Welcome Elementary made **AYP** (Adequate Yearly Progress) in 2009 and again in 2010 with 27 subgroups. Welcome did not make AYP in 2011 with the increase to 29 subgroups and the bar was raised but was able to maintain ratings of "average" for both growth and improvement and received the Silver Award in General Performance.

- School-wide implementation of 1:1 iPad technology
- Math facts fluency
- Increasing the rigor of assignments
- Providing individualized assistance based on Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and PASS data.
