

Blue Ridge Middle School sits atop one of the first ridges in the foothills of the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountain Range. Located in the northwestern corner of Greenville County, the peaceful Blue Ridge community is filled with friendly families who treasure their foothills heritage. Newcomers, drawn to the natural beauty, socially high morals and family values of this, the famous "Dark Corner" of SC, are warmly welcomed. Under the leadership of Principal Becky Greene, BRMS proudly offers students an excellent education that has produced notable academic success in recent years.

BRMS, now in its 28th year, is located on the original site of old Blue Ridge High School (built in 1954). With the construction of a new high school, the old buildings were completely renovated and transformed into modern, beautiful, and technologically current middle school campus in 2001. This, the largest geographical attendance zone in Greenville County School District, currently serves 935 students with challenging academics for grades six, seven, and eight.

Academic offerings at BRMS include high school courses: Honors Algebra I, English I Honors, Spanish, and Desktop Publishing, all of which earn Carnegie Units for participating students. Gifted and Talented classes are available in ELA and Math. A variety of extracurricular activities are available: Academic Team, Drama, Robotics, Student Council, Beta Club, baseball, softball, boys' and girls' soccer and basketball, girls' volleyball, marching band (in conjunction with BRHS), and an afterschool program that was begun this year.


