A look at the 2020-2021 School Year

Chandler Creek serves a diverse school population with over 600 students attending In- person Learning and over 300 attending Virtual Learning for the 2020-2021 school year. The school poverty index is 76.4 % allowing the school to qualify for Federal Funding.

The demographics equate to 50% Caucasian, 26% Hispanic/ Latino, 15 % African American and 9% as Indigenous, Asian or Multi Racial. Given the demographic breakdown, our students learn and grow in a community that values individuality and cultural experiences for students. Our school social and emotional foundation supports and models an inclusive mindset.

For the 2020- 2021 school year, Chandler Creek is honored to be named a Capturing Kids Hearts Showcase School. Our school day integrates good things or morning sharing sessions, daily affirmations for students and staff, and a launch which empowers students to move forward. Students learn questioning to redirect negative behavior and are allowed choice to take ownership of actions. Through the use of the Capturing Kids Hearts EXCEL model, a culture of relationships is built and nurtured for our students to become leaders, learners, and caring citizens.

Highlights of our school have been efforts by the School Improvement Council to support the philosophy of affirmation by mobilizing the local community to support teachers with gifts and self care items during the Covid Pandemic. The council has helped to extend communication to continue our Real Men Read Program virtually. The school has participated in it's first One School, One Book Initiative supporting the efforts to increase family engagement. Our Fabulous Five Team of students made it all the way to the Final Four in the Battle of the Books Competition. Our school is also honored to be a Special Olympics Unified Schools and this school year we are initiating an in house Special Olympics for our Self Contained Classrooms. These peak moments have helped our school provide a safe and secure setting for our students while creating events that have allowed increased student engagement overall. With 21st century learners ,where technology integration has become a norm for learning at home

and in school, Chandler Creek Elementary has created a school environment that is fluid and allows soft skills to be a focus for the future of college and career readiness.

The addition of before school tutoring and after school tutoring with the CCES Champion Club has allowed us to close gaps accrued during the Covid absences. Teachers and staff have benchmarked students regularly using data to drive instruction. Teachers have participated in Data Days and weekly planning to collaborate for student success. The teachers of Chandler Creek state that 100% of teachers agree that collaboration is a tool to improve teaching and learning. This data supports our Capturing Kids Hearts Philosophy for working as a team and placing value in the experiences of both teachers and students. This collaborative belief system allows our school to retain high quality teachers serving a generation of engaged learners.

Our school year continues to evolve and we visit our mission and vision is every decision that is made. The 2020-2021 school year has created a strong school culture that can face adversity while continuing to put students first and seeking excellence in all we do.

Be the I in Kind


Kindness week was a highlight as students learned and practiced the attributes of kindness.
