The 2019-2020 school year proved to be an historic year for our community as we navigated in-school learning to eLearning overnight. The testament to the hard work of our staff was evident as we reached out to students and families with Google Meet, Choice Boards, and Virtual Platforms to help bring content to life for students. We have immense gratitude for the hard work of all stakeholders as we strengthened our "Champion Spirit" while maintaining the safety and well-being of our community.
