The school contains 137,000 square feet of space that accommodates our current enrollment of 1,125 students. There are 50 classrooms (70% of which are equipped with state-of-the-art Promethean Boards), 14 labs, classrooms for fine arts and vocational education, along with a cafetorium for special performances and assemblies. Our physical education and sports facilities include a gymnasium, two softball fields, a football/ soccer field, a track, four paved basketball courts, and four tennis courts.

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

ΜΑΤΗ

- Highest PASS scores of any middle school in Greenville County, based on Spring 2011 PASS scores
- Offered Seven sections of honors high school credit math classes (five Algebra 1 and two Geometry)
- 100% pass rate on the Algebra 1 End of Course Examination since 2003
- Award-winning Math Counts Team, one of the top teams in South Carolina
- Highest PASS scores of any middle school in Greenville County for second year based on spring 2011 and 2012 scores

ENGLISH/LANGUAGE ARTS

- Offered broad range of ELA courses to meet the needs of students at every achievement level, ranging from inclusion and skills classes to grade-level and accelerated courses, including Gifted and Talented classes in every grade and English I Honors for eighth-grade students who excel in language arts
- **Consistently ranked among the top schools** in the district, based on PASS scores in both ELA (reading and research) and Writing
- English I Honors students posted exceptional scores on the state's End of Course Examination. In 2011, Riverside's mean score was 97%; more than 80% of the students made an A on the test. For 2012, the mean score was the highest of any middle school in Greenville County, including charter schools and the district's school for the gifted.
- Designated four times as Exemplary Writing School (every year of eligibility, since the school opened in 1999)
