

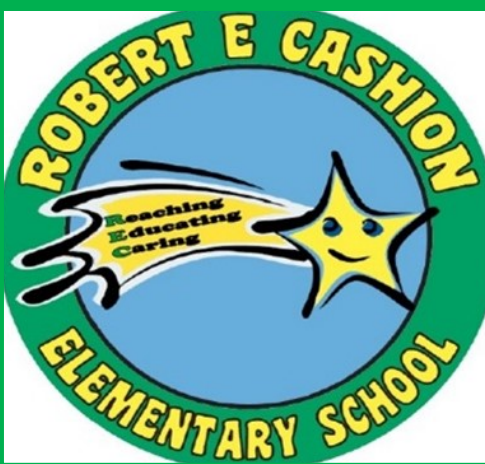
SIC Report to the Community

Due to the Covid school closure we do not have any SC Ready or SC PASS data to present. We are keeping our same goals from last year for the 2020-2021 school year. Our goals are listed below:

2020-2021—School Wide Goals

ELA: 54% of our students in grades three through five will score met or exceeding on the ELA SCReady.

Math: 55% of our students in grades three through five will score met or exceeding on the Math SCReady.

Science: 65.5% of our students in grade four will score met or exemplary on the Science SC PASS. .

Social Studies: 74% of our students in grade five will score met or exemplary on the Social Studies Mastery Connect Benchmark 3 Assessment.

Even with the challenges we have faced this year, we are looking forward to seeing the results of our efforts and dedication to our students and school families.
