

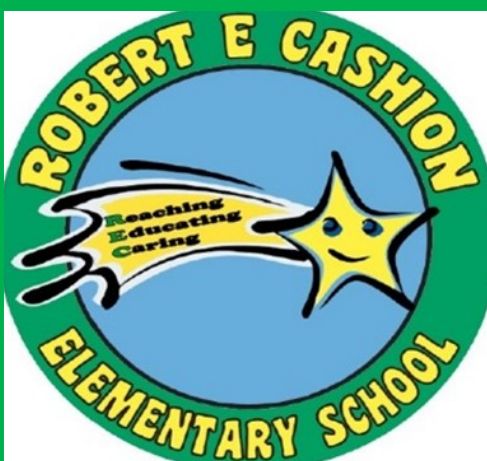
## SIC Report to the Community
