Message from the Principal

Beginning the school year 2004-2005, Cherrydale Elementary began operations as a new facility and is located on Perry Road in Greenville, SC. The new state-of-the-art building has the latest technological advances to enhance our instructional program. The two-story structure has a maximum capacity of 650 students. With the excitement of this new building and a “highly qualified” faculty and staff who are second to none, our students strive to reach the highest levels of academic achievement.

In August 2008, Cherrydale Elementary School implemented a single-gender initiative for students in grades 4 & 5. There is one class each for boys and girls at each of these grade levels. In 2010, this program was expanded to 3rd grade girls. Cherrydale’s single-gender initiative creates a learning environment that meets the individual uniqueness of gender through gender-based instruction. With the addition of understanding and incorporating multiple intelligences into the single-gender concept, Cherrydale is able to offer its students several avenues for increased rigor and enhanced student achievement.

Cherrydale Elementary School has also placed increased emphasis on reading and writing across the curriculum and implementing consistent problem-solving methods in math. Science continues to be a hands-on experience for the students and an extension of the curriculum taught in the classrooms.

Cherrydale Elementary School continues to strive for excellence and to ensure that its students reach the highest levels of academic and personal achievement.
