

School Achievements

In 2013, 81.75% of tested students achieved at “Foundational” levels or above on the State Alternate Assessment. Additionally, 97% of students mastered 80% or more of their IEP goals.

In the fall of 2013 the Unique Curriculum was implemented school-wide, aligning instruction with State standards.

In January of 2014 the SIC was re-established. Members and officers were elected, and the group was trained.
