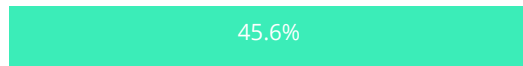
SCREADY-State Report Card Data

ELA- 60.8% of our students scored Meet or Exceeds

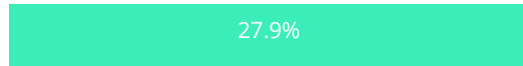
Math-42.3% of our students scored Meet or Exceeds
