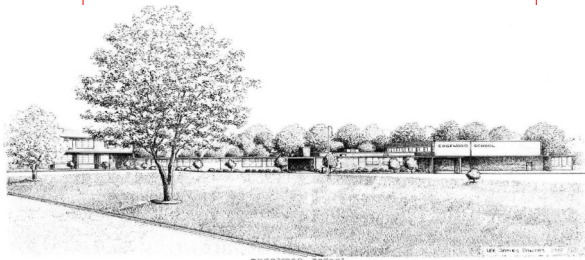


MISSION STATEMENT

Edgewood's Successes

According to the 2010 SC School Report card, Edgewood students scored above the state average of middle schools in the met/exemplary category of English Language Arts and above the state average in the met category for mathematics. In science and social studies, Edgewood also outperformed other middle school within the state.

Edgewood met the state's Annual Yearly Progress goals by meeting 17 of 17 objectives. According to Fall 2010 MAP data, 75.2% of all 6th graders are projected to meet or exceed the state's proficiency standards in reading, and 79.5% will meet or exceed in mathematics. In 7th grade, 75.5% of students are projected to meet proficiency standards or higher in reading, and 71.3% of the 7th grade are projected to meet in mathematics. In 8th grade, 83.2% of students are projected to meet or exceed standards in reading, and 70.2% are projected to meet in mathematics.

For 8th grade Algebra I students last year, 96.9% met or exceeded standards for the EOC test. Edgewood's attendance rate is higher than the state for both teachers and students.
