Edgewood's Successes

Edgewood began the school year with a brand new facility. We changed our colors to maroon and gold and changed our mascot to the "Wildcat".

We were able to continue a schedule that allowed block ELA and math classes in each grade. We have also continued with Study Island, MAP testing, PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support), and an Anti-Bullying education program school-wide.

We continue to believe these programs and our focus on literacy has helped improve our academic standing. According to the 2012 S.C. School Report Card, Edgewood students scored above the state in all four core subject areas plus writing.

Edgewood's student attendance rate was above the average of other middle schools. Our teachers earning advanced degrees increased along with the teacher attendance rate.

Edgewood received an "average" absolute rating and a "good" growth rating for the second year in a row. Because of our improvements, Edgewood was named a Palmetto Silver Award School for the second year. With new federal accountability, Edgewood received an above average grade of "B". We are proud of Edgewood's continued growth.
