## Goals for 2023-2024

### Student Achievement

Increase the percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring meets or exceeds by 3% on SC Ready in ELA and math

Incorporate inquiry-based units and lessons within the curriculum in order to engage students in active learning and real-world problem-solving

Implement targeted, small group reading instruction to increase student achievement in reading

### Teacher/Administrator Quality

Increase the number of teachers satisfied with home-school relations by 2% as indicated on the school's report card

### School Climate

Increase the percentage of parents satisfied with home-school relations by 2% as indicated by the school's report card

Provide opportunities for students to lead in-class conferences with parents regarding their achievements and grades
