On the Winter i-Ready Diagnostics, all grade levels demonstrated **High Growth** in Reading and Math!

Our retention rate for non-retirees was 96.8%, up from 92.9% the previous year.

97.6% of Parents report satisfaction with the learning environment and 94.9% of parents report satisfaction with home-school relations as indicated by the 23-24 School Report Card.

Prime instruction time is 90.8! This is up from 87.4 during the previous school year.
