The percentage of students on track for ELA is above the statewide average as indicated by our 22-23 School Report Card.

We are serving more 4K students! We added 1 more 4K class to our preschool program!

Our retention rate for non-retirees was 92.9%.

Satisfaction with Home-School Relations increased from 94.4% to 98.8% as indicated by the 22-23 School Report Card. 99% of parents report satisfaction with the learning environment.

We increased our instructional time by 25+ minutes in K5-2nd grades!
