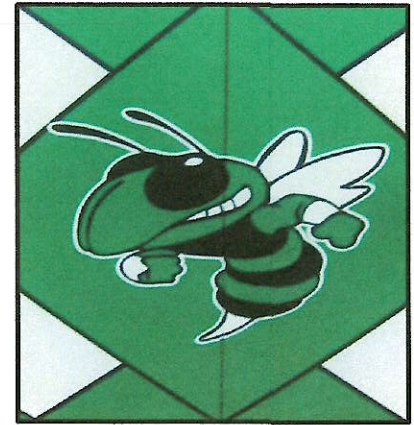

## Community Involvement

- The HES Junior Beta Club and the Boys Club prepared baskets for senior citizens at the Hampton County Council on Aging. The baskets included hand sanitizer, masks, and hand lotion.
- The Junior Beta Club sponsored a fundraiser called "Pennies for Patients" to raise money for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.
- The school sponsored a "Soup"er Bowl Canned Food Drive during the week of the Super Bowl. Over 600 food items were collected and distributed to local churches for their food pantries.
- The Junior Beta Club adopted Holly Street for the Adopt-A-Highway program several years ago. Recently, the club put on their orange vests and went out to collect litter along the road.
- HES teamed up with the Clemson University Extension and the Hampton County Rotary Club to clean the outdoor classroom. New tables were purchased for the area through the Clemson University Extension program.
- HES Wellness Initiative-We are embracing health and wellness and socio-emotional aspects in the lives of staff and students. We begin each day with a wellness tip and breathing exercises. We also have an afterschool walk group.
- HES students will raise money to support the Hampton County Animal Shelter. This fundraiser will be held in May. The last time this fundraiser was held, our students raised \$1000.
- Father/Daughter, Mother/Son, and Sweetheart dances were held this year.



## Accelerating Student Learning

- The Hornet Academy meets three days per week afterschool to provide intervention to students in reading and math. Over sixty (60) students are being served.
- The HES Boys/Girls Club meets three days per week afterschool to provide intervention in reading and math. A physical fitness component is also incorporated in their schedule.
- The STEAM Academy meets weekly (virtually and in person). The students have built balloon racecars, designed structures for an "Egg Drop" and participated in a virtual field trip to Mars.
- In-School Daily Intervention is being provided to students. Students rotate in cycles based on their academic progress.

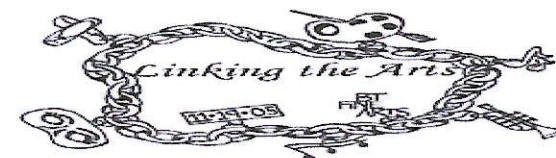
## Professional Development

- HES teachers and students have been trained in the use of Microsoft TEAMS and iReady assessments.
- HES 4th grade teachers received Fountas and Pinnell classroom curriculums. This comprehensive ELA Curriculum will be implemented fully starting next school year.
- *Through the **Read to Succeed Act (R2S)*** HES has a reading coach to support all teachers across all content areas. The goal is to help all teachers increase the literacy levels of all students through effective instructional and intervention strategies.
- HES has embedded weekly professional development (PLC) led by our instructional coach to make intentional decisions for continuous school improvement and professional growth.
