# **Community Involvement**

- The HES Junior Beta Club and the Boys Club prepared baskets for senior citizens at the Hampton County Council on Ag-ing. The baskets included hand sanitizer, masks, and hand lotion.
- The Junior Beta Club sponsored a fund-Ses for Por raiser called "Pennies for Patients" to raise money for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.



The school sponsored

a "Soup"er Bowl Canned Food Drive during the week of the Super Bowl. Over 600 food items were collected and dis-tributed to local churches for their food pantries.

- The Junior Beta Club recognized local law enforcement during Law Enforcement Week by providing "Goodie Bags" filled with treats.
- HES teamed up with the Clemson University Extension School Garden Program to provide students with hands-on aardening experiences. Students prepped, planted, and harvested cab-bage and broccoli in their winter garden and collard greens, lettuce, and snow peas in their spring garden.

# Accelerating Student Learning

- The Hornet Academy meets three days per • week afterschool to provide interven-tion to students in reading and math. Over sixty (60) students are being served.
- The HES Boys Club meets three days per week afterschool to provide intervention in reading and math. A physical fitness component is also incorporated in their schedule.
- The STEAM Academy meets weekly • (virtually and in person). The students have built balloon racecars, designed structures for an "Egg Drop" and participated in a virtual field trip to Mars.
- In-School Daily Intervention is being provided to students. Students rotate in cy-cles based on their academic progress.

#### **Professional Development**

- HES teachers and students have been challenged with virtual learning. Teachers and students have been trained in the use of Microsoft TEAMS and DreamBox.
- HES 4th grade teachers received Fountas • and Pinnell classroom curriculums. This comprehensive ELA Curriculum will be implemented fully starting next school year.
- Through the **Read to Succeed Act (R2S)** • HES has a reading coach to support all teachers across all content areas. The goal is to help all teachers increase the literacy levels of all students through effective instructional and intervention strategies.
- HES has embedded weekly professional • development (PLC) led by our instruction-al and reading coaches to make intentional decisions for continuous school improvement and pro-fessional growth.
