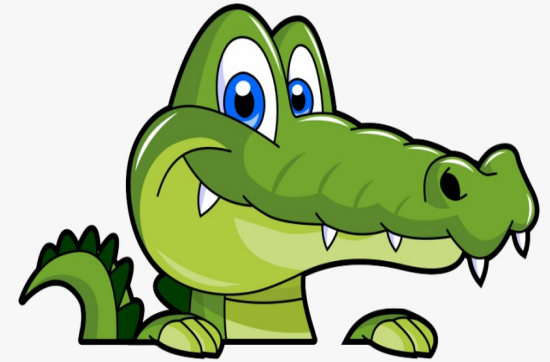

Student Assessments



i-Ready

An online assessment and instruction that helps teachers provide all students a path to proficiency and growth in reading and mathematics.
 This assessment is given 3 times a year for Grades K thru 5th
Fall to Spring

K-5th grade = 100% growth on Reading with Kindergarten with the highest gain

K-5th grade = 100% growth on Math with Kindergarten with the highest gain

Dream box

An online software math program that provides Pre-Kindergarten through 5th grade students with over 2,000 lessons presented as animated adventures, games, and challenges.

Waterford

A complete language arts curriculum for young learners from Pre-K to 3rd grade, covering crucial skills like phonemic awareness, phonics, text comprehension, vocabulary, print concepts, readiness skills, writing, and oral fluency. Also, the curriculum includes math and science.

SC Ready measure the South Carolina College- and Career-Ready Standards taught in ELA and Math classes.
