### Goals to Be Accomplished by 2015

- 95% of Algebra I, Math Tech II, and English I students will pass the End of Course test for their respective subject.
- At least 30% of AHS graduates will have taken at least one AP or IB course.
- Student attendance will be at least 96% each year.
- The composite SAT score will be above the national average.
- 90% of second-year students will meet the state's proficiency standard in ELA and math.
- 95% of second year students will pass both sections of the state's exit exam.
- 25% of graduates will qualify for LIFE Scholarships.
- 80% of the students will pass the State's U.S. History EOC test by 2012.

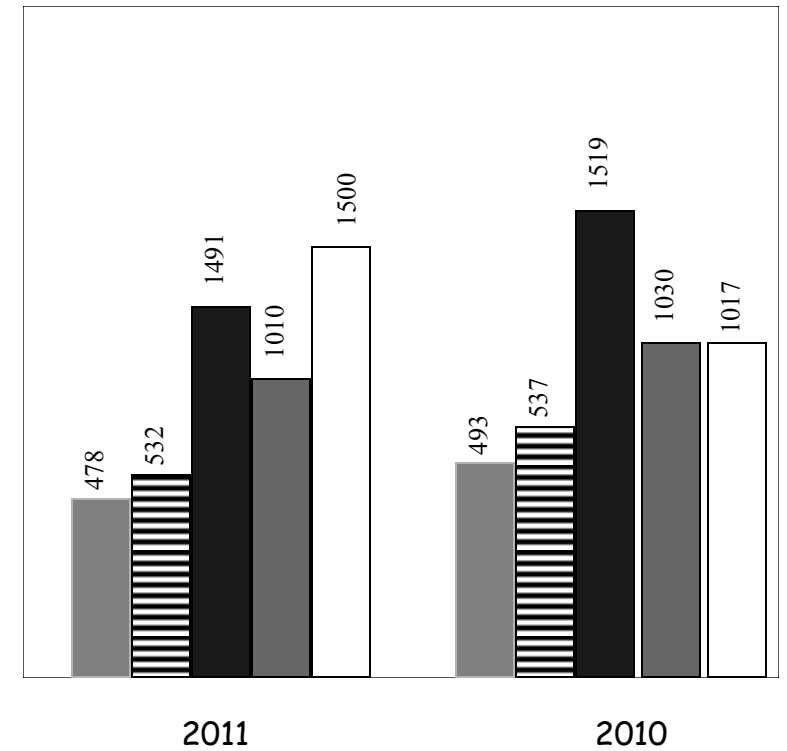

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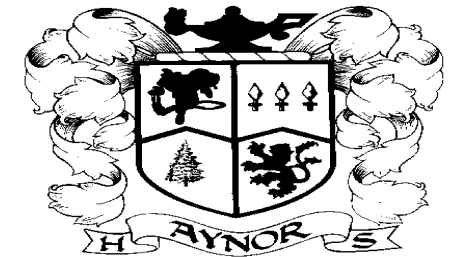
