Academics

Myrtle Beach High School offers twenty Advanced Placement Courses including: AP Spanish, AP Capstone, the AP International Diploma, and an AP Academy, Myrtle Beach High School surpassed the SC and Global Average in the majority of AP courses. In addition to AP course offerings, MBHS also offers, Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Engineering and Computer Science Courses, Dual Enrollment Opportunities through a partnership with Horry-Georgetown Technical College (HGTC), Teacher Cadet through a partnership with Coastal Carolina University (CCU), Work-Based Learning with Health Science internships, Seahawk New Tech Network, Accounting, General Management, Sports Medicine, Web and Digital Communications, NJROTC, Theater, Art, Music, College Prep and Honors Level Courses.

Navy JROTC

The NJROTC received the Distinguished Unit Award for the 5th consecutive year. The Drill Team won 1st Place overall at 6 Drill Meets and 2nd Overall at two other Drill Meets. We qualified for Area 6 (North/South Carolina) Drill Championships and finished 3rd overall out of 67 Schools. The Rifle Team was also crowned champions amongst the 9 JROTC rifle programs in Horry County, placed 1st South Carolina Junior Olympics for sporter rifle. The Academic Team competed and finished in the Top 20% on the National Academic Exam. Two Cadets received full academic scholarships to both the University of Marine and State University of New York (SUNY) Overall, NJROTC continues to represent the community, city, county, and the state very well by performing over 75 Color Guards and over 2500 hours of community service.

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
