75% this year.

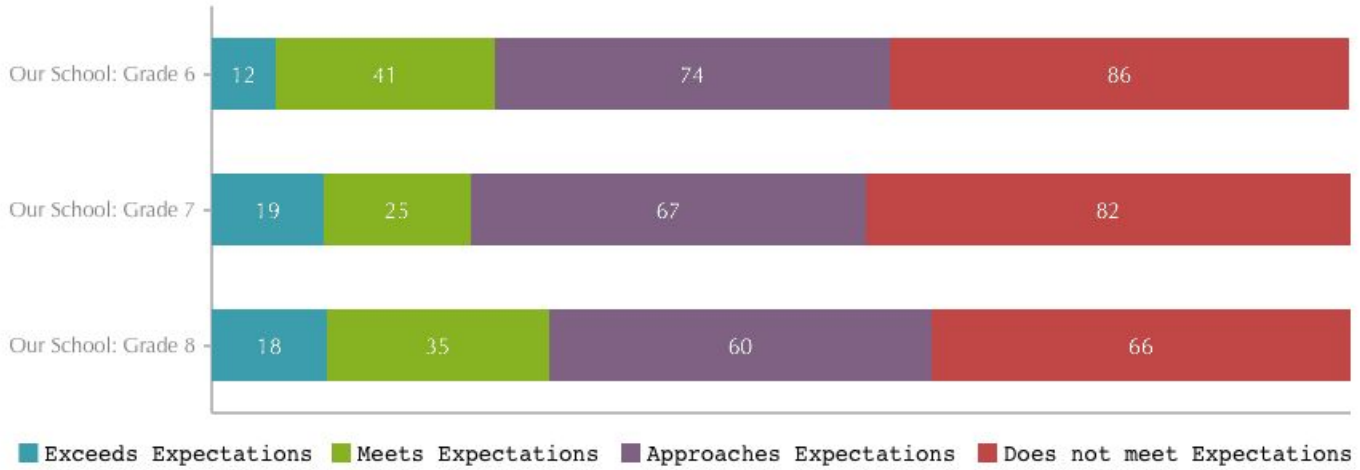
Title I Funds supported the following initiatives for the 2017-2018 school year:

- Professional Development

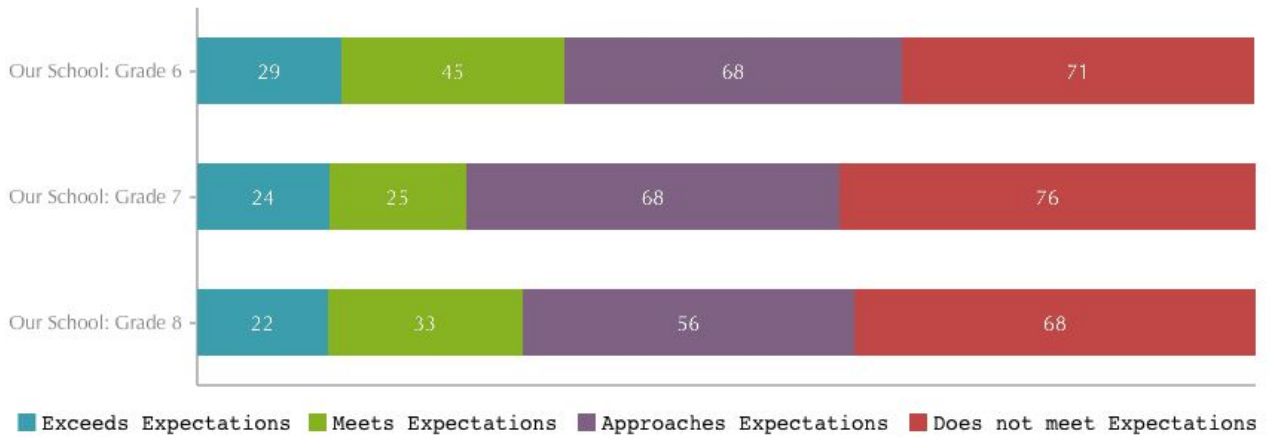
