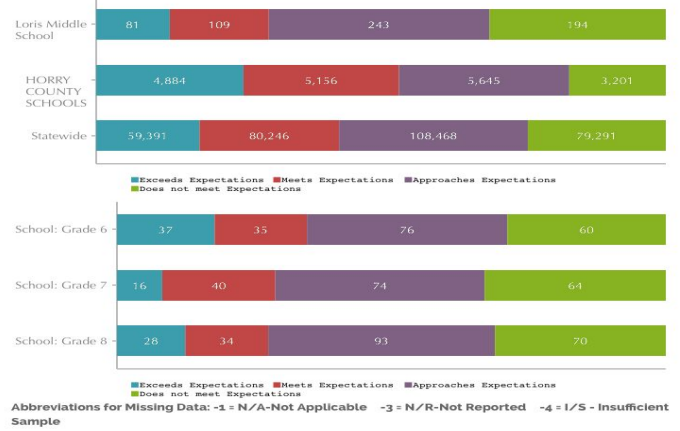

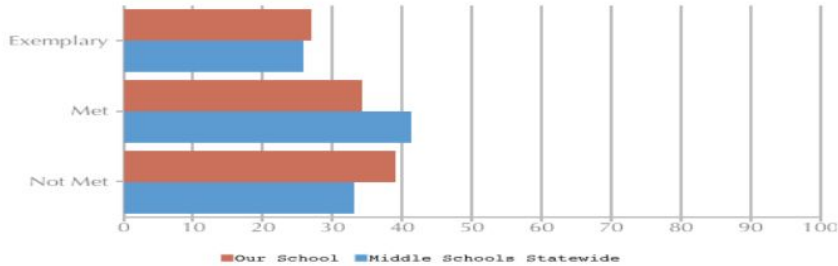


Mathematics



Spring 2016 SC PASS Results

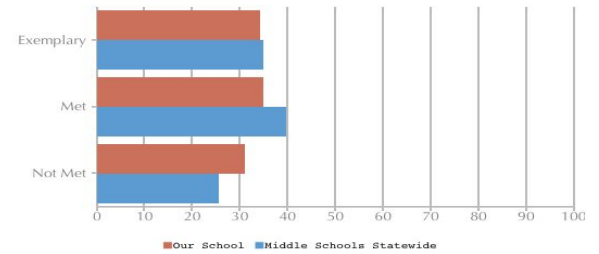
