Improvement Council's goals for 2019 were to enhance the school environment, leading to a direct impact on student achievement.

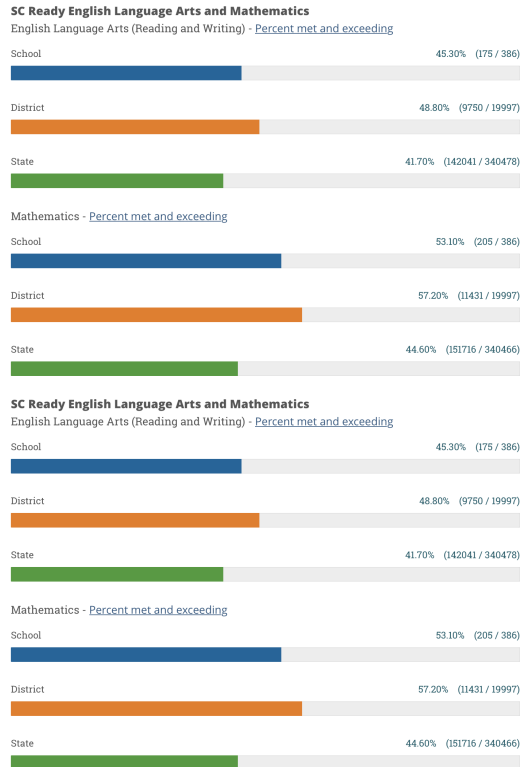
Purpose of the Report

Additional Information

Waccamaw Elementary School is located just outside of Conway, South Carolina. It is a part of the Carolina Forest attendance area. The school serves approximately 200 students in grades Pre-K through fifth grade in the 2017-18 school year. Currently, approximately 51% of WES students are Caucasian, 26% Black or African American, 15% Hispanic/Latino, <1% American Indian or Alaska Native, and <1% two or more races. The 2017-18 poverty index for WES is 76%. Currently Waccamaw Elementary School has 68 Professional staff members who work diligently to ensure growth and success for all students at WES.

WES PTO sponsors numerous events for students and families such as: Donut DADS, Munchkins for MOMS, and Christmas Shop, etc. They also provide appreciation opportunities and support throughout the year.

We have numerous partnerships with a variety of local businesses that support our school. These range from Walmart to The Disney Store.

Local churches and other organizations have provided monetary support, school supplies, clothing and shoes, gift cards for families in need.

The number of businesses and organizations that support our students, staff, and families are too numerous to name but everything we do is greatly appreciated.
