

BOY to MOY DIBELS Data





Math MAP to SCReady Correlation




Academics (MAP)

SES students in grades 2, 3, 4 and 5 participate in Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) testing twice a year in reading and mathematics. SES uses these scores to evaluate progress and predict achievement on end of the year state testing. This past year, however, state testing was cancelled due to the extended school closure. n
