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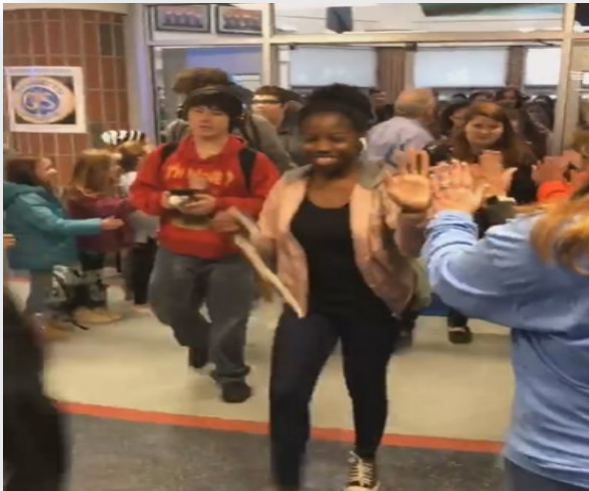


# School Improvement Council Initiatives

Here are just some of the initiatives your SIC undertook this year:

### Teenage Drug Use and Vaping Awareness Meeting

Given the proliferation of teenage vaping, drug use, and related health issues in recent years, the SIC chose to host an informational meeting for parents and community members. Working in conjunction with the school and the Horry County Police Department, the SIC was able to provide attendees with valuable knowledge to help keep our school and community safe!

### Measuring our Achievements

In the fall of 2018, the state of South Carolina released its first round of school report cards based on new criteria drawn from the federal *Every Child Succeeds Act* of 2015. Under these guidelines, schools are rated and ranked based on a number of factors, including end-of-course exam scores, on-time graduation rate, graduates' college and career readiness, the progress of English-language-learners, and overall student engagement.
