

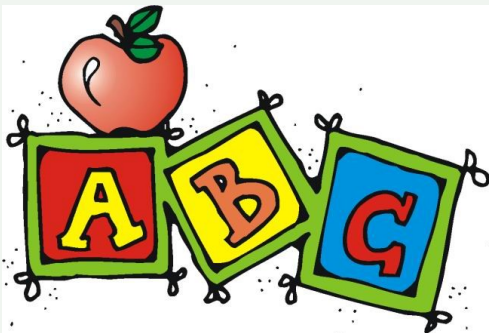
## Our Academic Gains

Based on our 2017-2018 SC Ready and SC PASS results, our students have made gains in the following areas:

ELA– 4.5 percent increase in the number of students scoring Met or Above school-wide

Social Studies– 6.9 percent increase in the number of students scoring Met or Above in 4th grade. Students in 5th grade demonstrated a 6.2 percent increase.

Science– 14.6 percent increase in the number of students who scored Met or Above in 4th Grade Science.
