Our Freshman Academy has continued the development and growth of each student and has incorporated a Zeros Are not Permitted program to reduce failure rate and improve ninth grade promotion. The collaboration with Central Carolina Community College has enabled us to expand our course offerings and allowed students to earn college credit while still enrolled in high school. In addition, we have increased student enrollment in Advanced Placement courses and expanded our college preparatory course offerings. The after school tutorial program provides academic support to our students and assist in improving the graduation rate and serves as an intervention to drop our prevention. Lugoff-Elgin High School is continuing chartering a specialized course of success for each student through our Advisor/ Advisee program and Individualized Graduation Plans.
