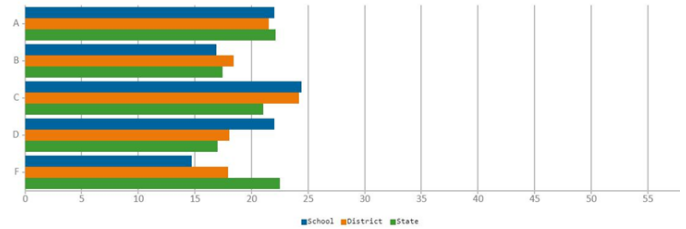
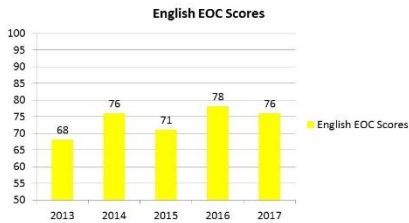


Figure 1 LEHS Algebra 1 EOC Grade Distribution

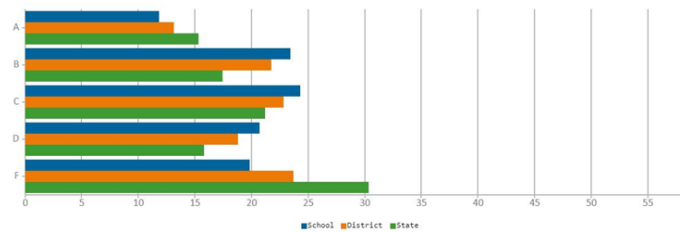
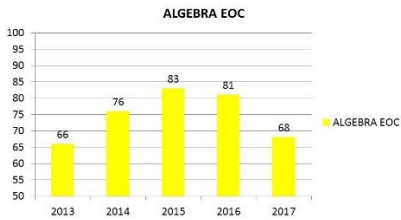


Figure 2 LEHS English 1 EOC Grade Distribution

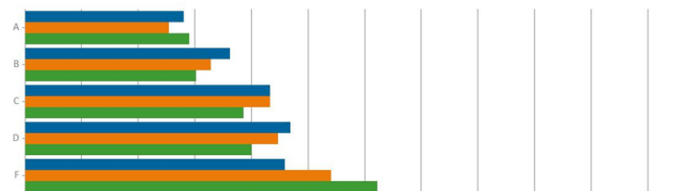
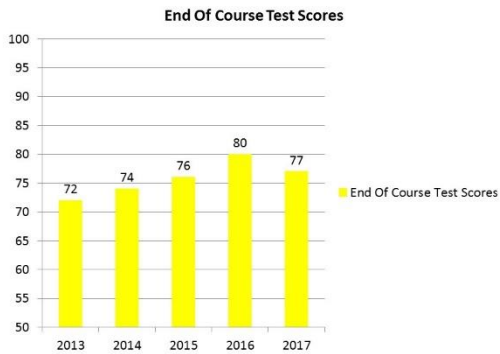


Figure 3 LEHS US History EOC Grade Distribution

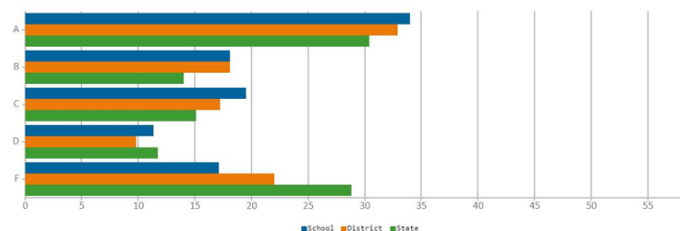
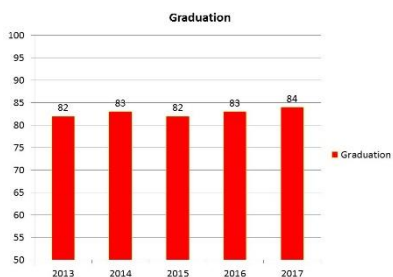


Figure 4 LEHS biology 1 EOC Grade Distribution
