Restorative Practices

We implemented a RESET room this year to teach children to regulate some of their emotions and to provide a safe space to recover from outbursts. Students were taught to Relax, Evaluate, Slow down, Empathize, and Think. Students reflect on behaviors and come up with plans on how to recover within the classroom.
