Measures of Academic Progress

MAP tests are electronically administered achievement tests designed to measure academic growth in reading, mathematics, and language. Students in grades K-5th are tested three times a year to show growth.

Behavior Progress:

Using the PBIS System (Positive Behavior Interventions and Support) Wateree Elementary has seen a decrease in infractions and referrals. Wateree Cardinals **SOAR** behavior stands for **Safe, Organized, Accountable, and Respectful**. Rewarding good behavior encourages Wateree students to always put their best foot forward. Students get to shop at the SOAR store with DOJO points that they earn for positive behavior. Students can also use points for participation in quarterly PBIS celebrations. Students who earn 500+ points are displayed on the "Wall of Fame."
