As this process reduces behavioral problems, it helps create and maintain safe learning environments where teachers can effectively teach and students can successfully learn. Stover's school-wide theme is "Tigers on the PROWL" (Positive, Respectful, Organized, Wise, and Life-Learners).

In addition to the PBIS framework, Stover Middle has implemented an "ENRICHMENT TIME" to help struggling students with their academics.
