


Purpose of the Report

Positive Behavior Initiative Support (PBIS)



PBIS has made a tremendous impact on the number of discipline referrals over the last three years. We utilize 5 "Fin-tastic" RAPS Rules: Safety, Respect, Order, On task, and Property. In addition, students are awarded Dolphin Dollars for demonstrating positive behaviors in the classroom as well as on the bus.



Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS)

The academic areas assessed include English Language Arts, math, science, and social studies. All 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders are tested in ELA, math, and writing. Fourth graders participate in all areas, while 3rd and 5th graders participate in either science or social studies.
