ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

At South Middle School our motto is, "Rock Your Role." We are a family and South lives up to this motto daily as it serves a diverse and ever evolving student population by simply rocking whatever your role may be; student, teacher, leader. South currently serves 487 students with one of the most diverse populations in the district at 49% African American, 29% white, 12% Hispanic, 1% American Indian, and 8% other. South serves grades 6-8 with 29% 6th grade students, 36% in 7th grade, and 35% 8th grade students. South also boasts a staff comprised of teachers and support staff from various ethnic and racial backgrounds, countries, and cultures. We believe at South that it takes a "family" to reach and educate our students. Teachers work using the junior high model to ensure that students are met both academically and social-emotionally. At South we offer a variety of avenues for students to pursue their interest while they develop the needed skills to be successful beyond middle school. Students are afforded the opportunity to grow through clubs, organized sports, academic competition, extended school day opportunities, and leadership responsibilities. The staff at South Middle School are continually working to evolve in their teaching craft to meet the needs of the 21st Century Learner. Teachers participate in school-wide professional development, continued education courses, graduate studies, as well as small group planning to create new methods for reaching all students.
