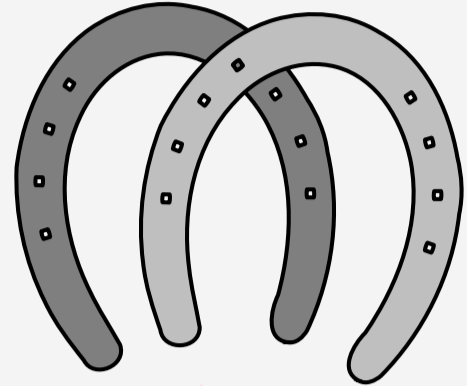

## About Our School

At South Middle School our motto is, "We are South. We are Mustangs. We are Family." South lives up to this motto daily as it serves a diverse and ever evolving student population. South currently serves 598 students with 31% of the population in 6th grade, 31% of the population in 7th grade and 38% of the population in 8th grade. Our racial demographics are some of the most diverse in the district with 48% African American, 13% Hispanic, 1% American Indian, 4% multi-racial, and 31% white. South also boasts a staff comprised of teachers and support staff from various ethnic and racial backgrounds, countries, and cultures.

We believe at South that it takes a "family" to reach and educate our students. Teachers work using the middle school model of teaming to ensure that students are met both academically and social-emotionally. At South we offer a variety of avenues for students to pursue their interest while they develop the needed skill to be successful beyond middle school. Students are afforded the opportunity to grow through clubs, organized sports, academic competition, and leadership responsibilities.

The staff at South Middle School are continually working to evolve in their teaching craft to meet the needs of the 21st Century Learner. Teachers participate in school-wide professional development, continued education courses, graduate studies, as well as small group planning to create new methods for reaching all students.
