
SOUTH CAROLINA PALMETTO ASSESSMENT OF STATE STANDARDS (2019)







END-OF-COURSE (EOC) TESTS (% passing)



INDIAN LAND MIDDLE SCHOOL

Indian Land Middle School earned a "Good" rating on the 2018-19 School Report Card. We have also earned recognition as a National School to Watch, a State School of Character, a National Promising Practices school, and a Palmetto Gold school. ILMS has collected numerous awards in music, robotics, band, academic challenge and dance competitions. Students consistently exceed school- and district-level expectations. These accomplishments, along with support from the community, keep us striving for more.

Indian Land Middle School incorporates project-based learning and lab-based instruction in our classes. We work to offer equitable learning that is also fast-paced. While our students have one-to-one access to technology, we continue to value learning time in the school's Media Center. ILMS provides career exploration and events, job shadowing opportunities, tours of our high school and district's career center, classroom guidance lessons, and Individual Graduation Planning conferences. We offer a variety of elective classes (STEM, Spanish, art, media/broadcasting, band, chorus, piano, and health/PE), as well as teaching and modeling service and spreading kindness within our building and in the community.

With a focus on literacy, each day our students have a dedicated reading time. This time allows for independent reading with student choice and for grade level novels with character education themes. Our teachers also focus on teaching/learning strategies to support our students. These strategies include communication/collaboration, thinking/problem-solving, questioning, expectations, and feedback. These strategies reinforce the World Class Skills of the Profile of the South Carolina Graduate as well as support Indian Land Middle School's goal of 100% Success!

This school year we have added an academic enhancement period once a month for students. During this time students get extra help/tutoring in areas that need more attention. We want to provide the tools needed to make all of our students successful.

We value partnerships and stakeholders who are invested in the success of our students and parental involvement. This summer we partnered with the South Carolina Governor's School for Science and Mathematics by having a week long STEM camp at our school. We want our students to become career and college ready.
