Because McDonald Green Elementary is an Arts and Basic Curriculum school . Students are given many opportunities to integrate the arts. Chorus, Honors Chorus and a Steel Drum Ensemble are offered after school. Students also participate in our new MGE Step Team, and Black Light group.

Our classroom teachers have integrated the arts through the use of project based learning, skits, and music to aid in the retention of information. Also, teachers have used reader's theater and tableaus after attending professional development workshops offered by the Lancaster County Council of Arts in partnership with the Kennedy Center of the Arts. Our regular classroom teachers will be attending arts institutes in the summer of 2014. McDonald Green's special area teachers are active in the regular classroom through the use of an inclusion model. Where applicable, students are given opportunities to explore dance, theatre, visual arts and music. McDonald Green utilizes every opportunity to expose our students to diverse forms of art to enhance learning.

We have an Art and Science class that meets after school. The Da Vinci class, the name given based on the life and work of Leonardo Da Vinci, incorporates art and science into one. Students who participate in this class have made projects from solar ovens to African rain sticks.

Due to students being in a "technology gaming" world" McDonald Green Elementary has a portable iPad Cart that teachers use for rotation stations in Math and Reading. The iPads enable teachers to differentiate learning. In order to assist students with academic deficiencies as well as learning acceleration, MGE implemented several new initiatives. District wide, Fast Forword, a computer based program to assist students with reading skills such as comprehension, phonics and context clues. Also, 3^{rd} through 5^{th} grade students were invited to attend Power Up 2 Score Up a one to one tutoring program afterschool for reading and math. In addition, each week during computer lab instructional time students have the opportunity to work in Study Island and Classworks. While teachers and volunteers work with small groups of students to increase academic achievement.
