
McDonald Green Elementary is committed to excellence by preparing students to be lifelong learners who can problem solve, think critically, and value the arts and diversity.

About Our School:

McDonald Green Elementary is a Title I school located in a rural community with 520 students. Our student population is 56% Caucasian, 33% African-American, 8% Hispanic, and 3% other. Students are given many opportunities to explore the arts.

Chorus, Honors Chorus, and a World Percussion Ensemble are offered after school. Students also participate in our new MGE Step Team, Black Light group, and Drama Troupe through our 21st Century Learning Program.









How We Integrate the Arts:

Our classroom teachers integrate the arts through the use of project based learning, theatre, visual art, creative movement, and music to aid in the retention of information.

Also teachers have used reader's theatre, tableaus, and visual art strategies after attending professional development workshops offered by the Lancaster County Council of the Arts in partnership with the Kennedy Center of the Arts.

Our regular classroom teachers will be attending arts institutes in the summer of 2015.
