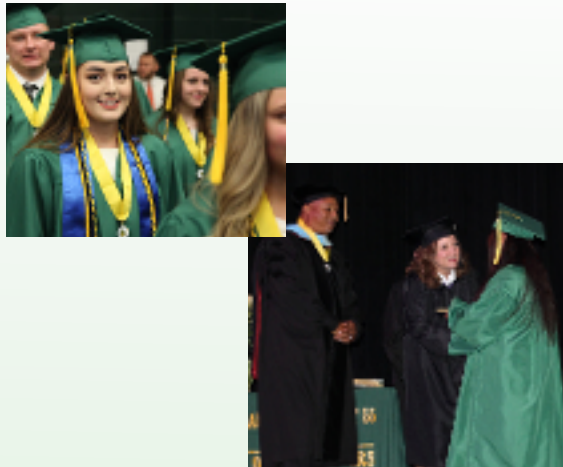
1. Increase the on-time (4 year cohort) student graduation rate from 80.7% to 81.05%

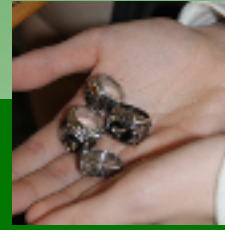

- The Academic Team qualified for the state championship for the fourth time in five years.
- 2 orchestra students qualified for Region Orchestra and 1 student qualified for All-State Orchestra
- 1 student made All-State Cross Country as a freshman
- 5 football players signed to play football at the college level
- 3 football players were selected as All-Region players.
- The football team qualified for playoffs for the 5th year in a row.
- The Robotics Team won the Palmetto Regional Competition
- Robotics finished 2nd at the Regional Championships Qualifier and Finished 1st in the Regional Championship Finals in Alabama, also earning the Chairmans Award.
- Robotics earned the opportunity to compete at the First World Championships in Houston, Texas
- Student Council earned the Citizenship and Patriotism Project award, Memberships and Motivational Development Project award, and 1 student earned the Student Councils Outstanding Leadership scholarship.
- The Raider Band won 1 Grand Championship, 4 first place awards, 4 high music and visual awards, 3 high percussion awards, 2 high color guard awards, Bands of American Regional Finalist, 2nd place at South Carolina Upper State Championships, 4th place South Carolina State Championships.
- The Concert band had 1 student selected for SCBDA All-State band, 6 students selected for the SCBDA Region band, Concert band and Symphonic Winds Band each earned the highest rating of Superior and the South Carolina State Concert Performance Assessment.
- Laurens FFA finished 6th in the state for Tractor Operation and Safety contest, 9th in Wildlife Career Development, 1 student earned the Region 2 State Fair Scholarship award.
- 5 FFA students earned State FFA Degrees
- Construction class partnered with hospice to construct wheelchair ramps for community members in need.

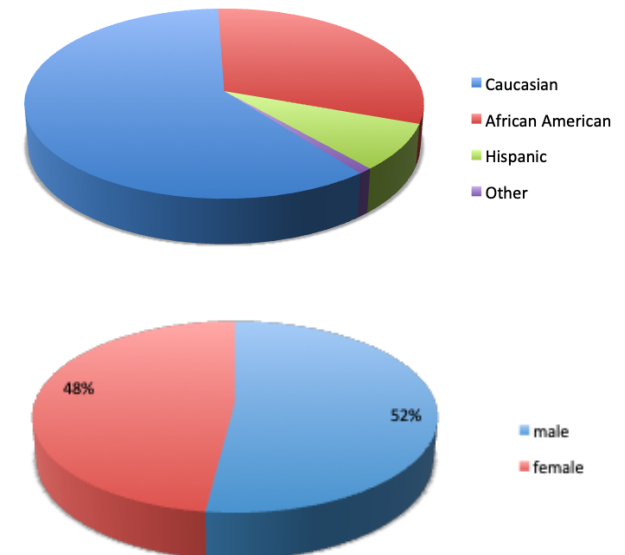
