## **Student Achievement**

Ford Elementary students showed growth in ELA and Math RIT scores from Fall to Winter on their MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Test:

#### 1st Grade:

- Reading: 4.9-point growth
- Math: 10-point growth

#### 2nd Grade:

- Reading: 7-point growth
- Math: 10-point growth

#### **3rd Grade:**

- Reading: 5.5-point growth
- Math: 8.1-point growth

#### 4th Grade:

- Reading: 5.2-point growth
- Math: 5.8-point growth

#### 5th Grade:

- Reading: 6.6-point growth
- Math: 6.4-point growth
