#### **SIC Annual Goals**

The goals of the 2024-2025 LES SIC focused on improving Student achievement, Instruction and student perception of the social-physical environment.

Goal 1: By Spring 2025, the percentage of students scoring proficient in ELA will increase from 42.2% to 52% on the SC READY summative assessment.

Goal 2: By Spring 2025, the percentage of students scoring proficient in math will increase from 39.1% to 50% on the SC READY summative assessment.

Goal 3: Laurens Elementary School will increase student perception of social-physical environment from 39% to 50% as measured by the school climate survey from 2023-2024 to the 2024-2025 school year.
