School Goal

In order to improve instructional outcomes at Gray Court-Owings Elementary/Middle School, the percentage of students meeting or exceeding expectations on the SC Ready assessment in ELA and math will increase by 10% from 2023-2024 to 2024-2025.

- 17% of 4th graders
