# PURPOSE OF THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL REPORT

This report is issued by the GCO School Improvement Council in accordance with South Carolina law to share information on the school's progress in meeting various goals and objectives, the work of the S.I.C., and other accomplishments during the school year.

### **SIC Annual Goals**

- Safety for all students: Safety is a top priority for our students. We have reviewed safety measures during our Safety Committee meetings, faculty meetings, and during grade-level meetings. Our staff has been trained on the RAVE 911 emergency programming system. Per district protocol, we initiate monthly fire drills, as well as practice other safety drills such as earthquake, tornado, and intruder as required by our school district. We are constantly assessing safety protocol and making necessary changes to ensure the safety of all students and staff to the best of our ability.
- **High-Quality Instruction**: GCO has taken steps this year to improve instruction, such as coaching cycles, uninterrupted instructional time, instructional expectations, data analysis during professional learning communities, professional development, and data-driven instruction. The focus has been on improving classroom instruction based on the SC Teaching Standards 4.0 rubric.
- Student Achievement: Academic Recovery has been a focus for GCO. Students have been able to participate in after-school tutoring, the 21st Century After School Program, and small group intervention sessions during the school day. Academic Recovery continues to be a priority, and instructional decisions for additional academic support continue to be made as we continue to monitor the progress of our students.
