2.) Powersville Elementary School will continue to encourage parent and community involvement to support student learning.

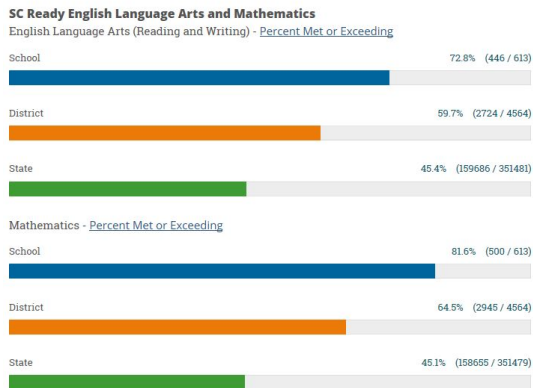
- Monthly PTSO and SIC meetings.
