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## CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN GOALS

- Increase the number of students and parents satisfied with the safety and security of school.
- Increase the overall percentage of students meeting standard (test score of 60 or higher) on state mandated End of Course test to 82%.
- Increase the number of students meeting benchmarks on college readiness tests.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving platinum, gold or silver on WIN.
- Increase the on-time graduation rate to 85.2% by 2021.
- Increase the number of teachers trained in AVID
- Increase the number of teachers trained in project based learning and personalized learning.
- Increase the number of teachers scoring at the highest levels on the SCDE Teacher Evaluation system.

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***All students at Clinton High School are provided with a Chromebook for 1:1 technology across all subject areas.***



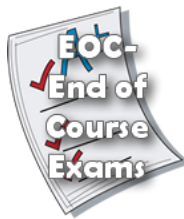
The ACT includes the Composite, English, Reading, Math and Science scores ranging from 1-36.

The highest Composite score for the SAT is 1600. For the two sections of the test, 800 is the highest possible for each. English, Reading, Math and Science Scores Range 1-36.

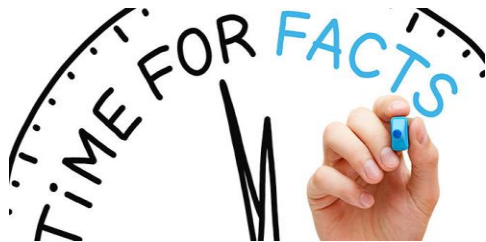

- 4 year graduation rate of **85.1%**.
- **80.1%** of Clinton High School seniors are eligible for the Life/Palmetto Fellow Scholarship.

- **82.4%** of Clinton High School 11th/12th grade students enrolled in dual enrollment courses complete at least six hours with a C or better.
  - **57.3%** of students are enrolled in Career and Technical Education courses.
  - **46.3%** of students taking AP courses score a 3 or higher on the AP exam.
  - **76.7%** of students who earn their diploma are considered college or career ready.
  - **73.6%** of Clinton High teachers have advanced degrees.
