Mission: Clinton High School is helping all students develop the world class skills and life and career characteristics of the Profile of the Graduate by expanding our existing programs and through the development of personalized learning.

IMPROVEMENT PLAN GOALS

- o By 2025-2026, 70% of our teachers will score "Evident" or "Very Evident" on the Eleot evaluation tool in the domain of "Students are actively engaged in the learning activities."
- o By 2026, 73% of our graduating seniors will be college or career ready as measured by the following: ACT Score 20, SAT Score 1020, AP Exam 3, Dual Enrollment 6+ Hours, WIN Score Silver 4, ASVAB 31, CTE Completer Recognized Credential Internship Work Based Industrial Evaluation 3+.
- o By 2025-2026, student scores on the end of course tests for Algebra 1 will increase by 1% each year..
- o By 2025-2026, the graduation rate will increase by 1% each year in order to meet and/or exceed the state graduation rate.
- o By 2025-2026, there will be a decrease by 5% in the number of in school and out of school suspensions for the overall student body.

- 4 year graduation rate of **81.2%**.
- **60.1%** of Clinton High School seniors are eligible for the Life Scholarship.
- **45.6%** of students are enrolled in dual enrollment courses.
- **54.1%** of students enrolled in an AP course received a score of 3 or higher.
- **640** students are enrolled in Career and Technical Education courses.
- **60.6%** of students who earn their diploma are considered college or career ready.
- **101** Juniors and Seniors are enrolled in Dual Enrollment courses.
- **73.6%** of Clinton High teachers have advanced degrees.
