# PRINCIPAL'S CABINET/SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL REPORT ON PROGRESS

#### 5 Year Growth for CHS:

- Overall passage rate on end of course tests has increased from 55.8% to 71.6% with our students now exceeding the state average in English I and Biology.
- CHS 4-year graduation rate has increased from 65.2% to 80% or above consistently for two years.
- Increased our Advanced Placement test passage rate from 18.4% to 31%.
- o Number of students enrolled in dual enrollment courses has increased to 189 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students registered for college courses through USC Union and Piedmont Technical College on and off our campus. These students have a 97% success rate in these courses and are earning college credit while still in high school.
- The number of Seniors eligible for LIFE Scholarship has increased from 33.7% to 63.4%.
- 70% of students from the 2015 CHS Graduating Class were enrolled in a two- or four-year college or technical college pursuing an Associates' degree, certificate, or diploma in Fall 2015.
- The class of 2016 earned over \$7.4 million in college scholarships.
